Roland Thomas "TD" Akers, Sr., 93, of Whiteside, passed away Tuesday, October 17, 2023 at Mercy Hospital St. Louis.

Funeral services for TD will be Saturday, October 21, 2023 at 1:00 p.m. at Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes and Crematory in Bowling Green with Pastor Bill Patrick officiating. Burial will be in St. John's Cemetery in Eolia. Visitation will be from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the funeral home. A dinner will follow services at the Eolia Community Center.

TD was born August 27, 1930 in Eolia, Missouri to Richard and Lottie (Dameron) Akers. He was united in marriage to Lydia Mae Michael on May 8, 1976 in Hannibal. Lydia survives.

TD grew up and lived in Eolia most of his life. He attended school in Eolia until he left school to join the Army. He served his country during the Korean War stationed on the front lines Infantry. While serving, he was shot three times and received a much-deserved Purple Heart. Following the war, he returned home and was employed with several trucking companies before starting his own company, Akers Construction. He owned and operated this company for almost 60 years.

TD belonged to the Eolia VFW, then transferring to the Clarksville VFW. He

was also a member of the Eolia Methodist Church.

TD enjoyed working. He also liked attending fish fries and going out to eat.

He is survived by his wife, Lydia Mae of Whiteside; children, Roland T. Akers Jr. of Bowling Green and Kathy (Dave) Labeau of House Springs, Missouri; two step-children, Richard Lee Ochs Jr. of Clarksville and Randal L. E. (Jesscelia) Ochs of Clarksville; and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

TD was preceded in death by his parents; daughter, Nancy Loree; step-son, Robbie Ochs; grandchild, Chris Yager; and six siblings.

Roland was a kind, loving and generous gentleman. He never met a stranger and never said a negative word about anyone. He especially loved his family and their visits. He will be missed by all of those who knew and loved him.

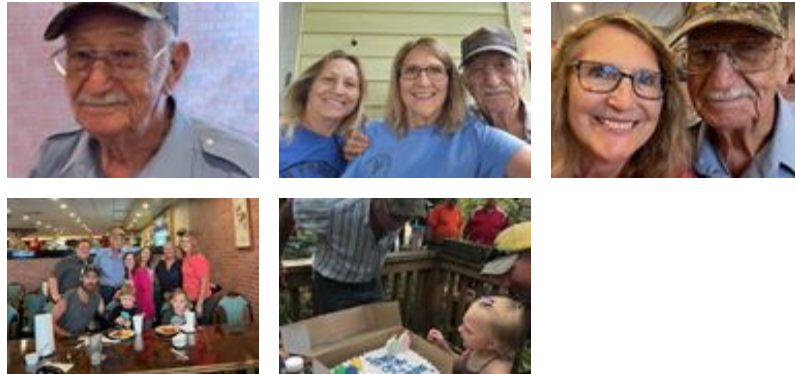
