Russell Jeffrey "Jeff" Miller, 64, of Curryville, passed away April 3, 2025, at Hannibal Regional Hospital.

Funeral services for Jeff will be held Monday, April 7, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the Curryville Presbyterian Church with Pastor Shonda Galloway officiating. Burial will be in the Curryville Cemetery. 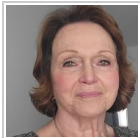
