Salvatore (Sam) Joseph Signorello, age 73, of Bowling Green, passed away Sunday November 2, 2014 at his residence surrounded by his family. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 am on Wednesday, November 5 at the St. Clement Catholic Church with Msg. Walter Whited and Fr. Bill Peckman officiating. Burial will be held at Sacred Heart Cemetery in Florissant. Visitation will be held from 4:00 pm until 8:00 pm on Tuesday at the Mudd-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green.
