Shirley Ann Elliott, age 82, of Bowling Green, MO, passed away August 26, 2025, surrounded by her family following a short illness.

Graveside services will be held at 11:00am on Friday, August 29, 2025, at Greenlawn Cemetery in Bowling Green with Rev. Cole Branstetter officiating. Bibb-Veach Funeral Homes & Crematory in Bowling Green are handling arrangements.

Shirley was born February 21, 1943, in Perry, MO. She was the youngest of 11 children to William and Bessie (Krigbaum) Goodhart. Born and raised in Perry, she was Christian by faith, attended Perry public schools and shortly after graduating, married Calvin Elliott on June 6, 1961, and began her family. Shirley and Calvin were united in marriage for 40 years until his passing December 11, 2001, and together they raised two daughters who carried on their legacy.

Shirley and Calvin moved to Bowling Green shortly after uniting in marriage and spent many years owning and operating Elliotts' Green House in Bowling Green. Following the closure of the greenhouse, Shirley spent her days delivering meals for Meals on Wheels in Pike County.

Shirley enjoyed the companionship of Jack Spegal for the past 22 years and

together they enjoyed being with family, going to casinos, as well as going to local opries where they enjoyed listening to country music and dancing.

Shirley leaves behind her daughters, Tammy Douglas of St. Joseph, MO, and Cindy Elliott of Bowling Green; grandchildren Jenna, Emma, Benjiman, Dustin, Daylan, Amber, and Adam; great grandchildren Jordan, Jaiden, Justice, Grayden, Brylee and Noah; great-great grandchild Parker and extended family.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband and ten siblings.

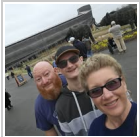
