Stephen M. Lilley, age 37 of Frankford, passed away Sunday August 10, 2014 at his residence surrounded by his family. Funeral services will be held 11:00 am Wednesday at the Mudd-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. Paytie Hinch and Dave Rubemeyer officiating. Burial will be in the Riverview Cemetery in Louisiana. Visitation will be held Tuesday from 4:00 pm until 8:00 pm at the funeral home.

Stephen was born July 14, 1977 in Louisiana, the son of Richard Thomas and Vickie Beth Stephens Lilley.
