Susan Gamm, age 76, of rural Bowling Green, Missouri, passed away at the Maple Grove nursing home May 18, 2026.

Visitation for Susan Gamm will be Thursday, May 21, 2026, at Bibb-Veach Funeral Home from 4-8 pm. A memorial worship service will be at the Curryville Baptist Church on Friday, May 22, at 10:00 am.

Susan was born on December 20, 1949, to Billie Joe and Doris Rader Chapman. She was a member of Second Baptist Church of Bowling Green where she grew to know Jesus Christ as her Savior and was baptized as a child. She graduated from Bowling Green High School with the class of 1967. Susan married Jerry Gamm on September 18, 1968, and was blessed with two children, Stephanie and Tim.

Susan taught in the Bowling Green School District for 30 years. She started working as a teacher's aide for two years and decided to continue her education earning a teaching degree from Northeast Missouri State University. Mrs. Gamm then taught 4th grade at Bowling Green Elementary for 26 years. She retired from full-time teaching to begin tutoring at Frankford Elementary for an additional four years. Throughout her teaching career, she touched the lives of countless students, colleagues, and families.
