Suzanne Bea Sidwell, age 49, of Louisiana, passed away unexpectedly Thursday, October 26, 2023 at her residence.

Her daughter recalls many days of her mother cheering on her favorite drivers like Jeff Gordon, Dale Earnhart, and Tony Stewart. She loved anything fluffy, but especially her cat which she named fluffy. Above all, Suzanne was very proud of her daughter for moving away and attending nursing school and graduating. She was also a proud grandmother.
