Tammy Lynn Calhoun, surrounded by her loving family, passed away at her home Tuesday evening, June, 18, 2024, following a two-year fight with multiple melanoma.

A family led memorial service will be held at 11:00am Saturday, June 22, 2024 at the Frankford Baptist Church in Frankford, MO with Rev. Randy McDonald officiating. Visitation will be held from 10:00 am until time of services on Saturday at the church.
