Terrace Eugene Boudinier, 105, of Bowling Green, passed away Friday, August 8, 2025, at Lynn's Heritage House in Louisiana, Missouri.

Funeral services will be Tuesday, August 12, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Bowling Green with Pastor Bruce Moeller officiating. Burial will be in Riverview Cemetery in Louisiana with full Military Honors provided by American Legion Post 370. Visitation will be Tuesday, August 12th from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the church.

Terrace was born June 6, 1920, in Perry, Missouri to Artie and Lucille (Farrell) Boudinier. He was united in marriage to Margaret "Evelyn" Lewis on September 22, 1940. Evelyn preceded him in death on July 27, 2002.

Terrace and his family moved to Bowling Green when Terrace was young. He attended Bowling Green Schools and was a graduate of Bowling Green High School. He was employed with Kroger in Bowling Green for 40 years. Terrace was a member of the Masons and the Eastern Stars over 75 years, in which he held many offices. He also served as a Scout Master when his son was younger.
