Vera Marie Orr Dixon went to be with the Lord on November 12, 2020, at the age of 103 years, 11 months, and 5 days.

Funeral arrangements are with Bibb-Veach Funeral Home. A private graveside service will be held on Monday, November 16, 2020 with Pastor Paul Lewis officiating. Burial will be at Curryville Cemetery.

Vera was the third of four daughters, born December 7, 1916 to Thomas Phillip and Sarah Elizabeth Branstetter Orr on the family farm near Curryville, Missouri.
