Wayne Jeffrey Seiller Sr., 71, of Bowling Green, MO., left this world to be with his Heavenly Father on Tuesday, September 5th.

Memorial services will be held at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, September 13, 2017 at the Bibb-Veach Funeral Home in Bowling Green with Rev. JR Brown officiating with military honors being conducted by VFW Post #5553 and the Missouri Military Honors. Visitation will be held from 5:00pm until 7:00pm on Wednesday, at the funeral home.

Wayne was born on April 13th, 1946 in St. Louis, MO, the youngest of 4 children to Walter and Pearl Seiller. He married Nellie Rose Hansen, daughter of Ronnie and Juanita on October 25th, 1974 at Curryville Baptist Church in Curryville, MO. She survives.
